## Professional in Human Resources Certification

Students graduating within the next 12-months can take the PHR Certification exam at a reduced cost. **Pass your exam now** – then once you obtain two years of professional HR work experience, you are officially certified and can use the PHR professional designation. Certification is granted by the HRCI-Human Resource Certification Institute.
